Vocalise is a student led charity that looks to help with the rehabilitation of prisoners by teaching them how to debate and helping develop their confidence. Volunteers are trained over a number of months both how to debate and how to teach debating before going into prisons. I taught in both male and female prisons as well as a Young Offenders Institute, with one team debating successfully against the Oxford Union.

During my time as a student at Regent's Park College I took an active role in access to Oxford, helping prospective students from a wide variety of backgrounds in admissions week.

I spent over 4 months teaching English as a foreign language in central Tanzania after finishing my A Levels. I was responsible for teaching classes of over 50 students between the ages of 13 and 19 and took an active role in the running of extra-curricular activities, a particular highlight being the organising of a school wide 'talent competition' that both the students and the teachers took part in.
